Conditions of Application

1. The Scholarship is open to members or children of members of the Upper Clutha A & P Society provided they have been financial members for at least a full year prior to application. The level of involvement in the running of the society may be taken into account when deciding the successful applicant.
2. The Scholarship is to assist with the fees or monies directly related to the education and training at an educational institution in any subject related to a facet of the society's annual show.
3. The Scholarship of \$1000.00 per annum is granted from the commencement of each year on production of evidence that the applicant has been accepted for an approved course and/or purchases made in relation to the approved course.
4. In the event of the successful applicant not completing their course, then a pro-rata sum of the grant already advanced shall be reimbursed to the Society.
5. The Executive Committee reserves the right to withhold the payment of any amounts due under the Scholarship in the event the Scholarship recipient conducting themselves in a manner which is likely to bring the Society into disrepute.
6. In view of the purpose of the Scholarship, other finance available to applicants will be taken into account when deciding the successful applicant.
7. The recipient shall, on the completion of each year's studies, furnish copies of official results to the Society for retention in their records. Applicants must pass previous years' study before following year's funding is awarded.
8. The Executive Committee reserves the right to award more than one scholarship or not award the scholarship in any year in full or in part.
9. The decision of the Executive Committee will be final and no correspondence will be entered into after the successful applicant has been chosen and the result published.
10. Applications' are to be received in writing detailing course to be taken, cost and length of course and a brief personal statement detailing involvement with the society and why the course has been selected. This is to be with the society by **30 November**.
