The RunWay Art U Wear is a wearable arts fashion show. It is an opportunity to design something sustainable from recycled materials.

What can you win if you enter?

Overall Winner will receive 1st prize of \$500 cash prize plus weekend package at Milbrook Resort, Queenstown sponsored by Hook.

Each category will have its own prize package valued at \$250.

The primary school category will win a Paper Plus voucher valued at \$100.

If you win a category prize are you still eligible to win the overall prize?

The overall winner will not be a category winner.

Do you need to provide a model for your creation?

Each entry needs to come with its own model.

Do you need to find music and choreograph a routine for your entry?

As this is a fashion show the organisers will choose music for each category and on Thursday 10 March at 5.00pm the designer and model will need to be present at the Rugby Club Rooms for a dress rehearsal.

What is the closing date for entries?

All entries need to be in by 1 December 2020.

Will you accept late entries?

Late entries will be accepted but you will need to pay a late entry fee.

What does it cost to enter?

There is no charge unless you are a late entry.

What will the judges be looking for?

The judges will be looking for originality, creativity, use of recycled materials and how sustainable the outfit is.
