What does the RunWay Art U Wear mean?

The RunWay Art U Wear is a wearable arts fashion show. It is an opportunity to design something sustainable from recycled materials.

What can you win if you enter?

Do you need to provide a model for your creation?

Each entry needs to come with its own model.

Do you need to choreograph a routine for your entry?

Optional. The runway is 15 metres long with a rectangle in the middle, models are required to walk up and down but you are able to be creative with how you use the space.

All entries need to be in by the 18 December 2021.
