STEWARDS WILL BE AVAILABLE FROM 4pm ONWARDS TO ASSIST WITH LOADING.

RULES & REGULATIONS

- S1a. In the Merino Sections, the onus of classification is on the Exhibitor. For the guidance of exhibitors, the usually recognised standards for Merino Wool are: Superfine 18.9 and finer; Fine 19-20.9 microns; Medium 21-22.9 microns; Strong, 23 and stronger.
- S1b. All adult ewes in the sheep classes must, in the Judge's opinion, have reared a lamb.
- S1c. All Romney Sheep entered must be in natural condition.
- S1d. All Merino entries to be held by the exhibitor.
- S1e. BRUCellosis - All sheep entered in the Show must be from a flock currently accredited Brucellosis free. Entries will be accepted from ABF breeders with status being confirmed by Breed Societies. Brucellosis Certificates must accompany entries. Entries not meeting accreditation will not be accepted and will be returned by post.

Prime Gift Lamb

- S2a. No entry fees
- S2b. Lamb becomes property of the Society.
- S2c. To be judged on total commercial value.
- S2d. Entire lambs eligible.
- S2e. Prize money: 50% of the total value of Gift Lambs makes up the prize pool and is paid out. 40% of the pool goes to the winner; 30% for 2nd and 20% for 3rd, 10% for 4th. Winners will receive their money by direct credit or cheque.

Protests, Judges' & Committee's Rights

- S3a. The Judges are empowered to withhold the prizemoney in any department in which there are not sufficient funds.
- S3b. The Stewards in the various classes are enjoined and empowered to prevent any persons interfering with the Judges during adjudication and no exhibitor or other person otherwise than the Judge, Stewards and Livestock Secretary will be permitted to go inside the ring/pen while the exhibits are being judged, except in such cases as the Stewards may deem necessary.
- S3c. All Protests to be lodged with the Livestock Secretary accompanied with a deposit of \$50, within half an hour of adjudication and if, in the opinion of the committee such protest is deemed frivolous, the deposit to be forfeited.
- S3d. Any person infringing the rules of the Society will be liable to a penalty not exceeding \$50. The attention of exhibitors is particularly directed to the foregoing provisions which will be strictly enforced or will revert to the funds of the Society.
- S3e. Any exhibitor or person in any way interfering with or using improper language to the Judges or any officer of the Society in, or as to, the execution of their duty, or being guilty of improper conduct on the Showground, may be disqualified upon exhibiting in future Shows of the Society, and if exhibiting at this Show, may forfeit all prizes he or she has won.
- S3f. Any person having been expelled from membership, or disqualified from exhibiting, riding or competing by any kindred association shall not be allowed to become a member, or to exhibit, ride or compete at this Society's exhibitions, until such expulsion be rescinded or such disqualification be removed, provided such expulsion or disqualification be confirmed by the Executive of this Society.

- S3g. Arrears: No person who is in arrears with regard to entry fees, subscriptions or any other Show charge is eligible to compete at any A & P Show. Proof of payment will be required before any restriction will be lifted.
- S3h. The decision of the Committee shall be absolutely final on any subject on Show Day.
- S3i. Officials have the power in Sheep Sections to move stock to their correct classes with the approval and on advice of judges.
- S3j. The RAS 'Yellow Card' system; please read full rule wording under the General Information Section of this schedule.

Entry Fees, Prize Money, Points & Admission

- S4a. Any commendable extra stock to receive honorary mention.
- S4b. The Committee may reserve the right to allot Specials in lieu of prize money mentioned in this schedule.
- S4c. All Livestock prize money will be directed credited after the show. Please include your name and bank account number on your Entry Form. For Gift Lamb winners you will be paid by cheque after the show.

- S4e. Points for Special Prizes in the aggregate: first 5, second 3, third 1, unless otherwise specified.
- S4f. Ticket allocation – one two-day pass issued per 4 animals
- S4g. All sheep entries close with the Livestock Secretary on 11th February 2022.
- S4h. Entry Fees must accompany all entries. Late Entries will be charged an additional \$15
- S4i. In the event of a single entry in any class, the competitor will be awarded half the first prizemoney.

Scratching & Refunds

- S5a. Refund of entry fees will only be considered if scratchings are made officially with the Livestock Secretary either prior to the Show or in sufficient time to avoid disruption to the smooth running of the competition. i.e. full refund if scratching is made before Friday 25th February. 75% refund if scratching is made before Thursday 3rd March 2022, 4pm. No refund will be given after this time unless a vet certificate is produced. Yard fees will be refunded in full.
- S5b. If a veterinary certificate is produced refunds will be in full.

Responsibility & Liability

- S6a. The Committee will not under any circumstances hold itself responsible for any loss, damage or mis-delivery of stock or other exhibits at the Show.
- S6b. Police and security will protect property as far as possible. Security staff will be on duty from Thursday 6pm – 7am Friday; Friday 6pm – Saturday 7am; Saturday 6pm – Sunday 8am till Sunday 9am.
- S6c. Entries to be on the ground and stock yarded by 8.30am Saturday. Judging to commence at 9am sharp and on no account will be delayed for exhibits not to hand. All judges are requested to be on the ground at 8.45am.
- S6d. No exhibits can be removed from the ground before 4pm except with an order from the Chief Steward.

Show Cancellation Policy

- S7a. If the Show is abandoned or postponed due to any reason beyond the control of the Society, the Society is under no obligation to refund in whole or in part any payments made by the Exhibitors. Any refund will be at the sole discretion of the Society.
- S7b. The Society will not be liable for any delay or failure to perform its obligations to the extent that such delay or failure results from a Force Majeure Event and while the Force Majeure Event continues. The Society will give the Exhibitor written notice as soon as reasonably possible containing details of the circumstances giving rise to the Force Majeure Event. The Exhibitor acknowledges and agrees that it will not be entitled to any reimbursement of any fees paid where a Force Majeure Event disrupts the Show. The Society may in its absolute discretion refund in whole or in

part, any payment made by the Exhibitor - or waive any payment the Exhibitor is liable to make under these Terms.

- S7c. For the purposes of clause S7b "Force Majeure" means an event or occurrence which is beyond a party's reasonable control (including, without limitation, acts of God or the public enemy, flood, earthquake, storm, cyclone, tornado, hurricane, lightning, fire, explosion, epidemic, war, embargoes, riot or civil disturbances, sabotage, expropriation, confiscation or requisitioning of facilities, the imposition of disabling exchange rate controls, orders or temporary or permanent injunctions of any duly constituted court of competent jurisdiction); and which the affected party could not have reasonably foreseen or taken reasonable measures to prevent

Disclaimer of Liability

All competitors acknowledge there are inherent risks involved in participating in show activities

Neither the organisers of the event to which these rules apply nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, vehicles, their contents and accessories or any other personal property whatsoever whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract, or in any other way whatsoever.

NB. Under law it is not possible to sign a waiver which would protect a facility owner, farmer, employer or other person from liability should an accident occur as a result of neglect to take all practicable steps. The facility owner, local authority or farmer etc cannot "contract" out such responsibilities by requesting a waiver of liability.
